## Question 1 [5 marks]

- In part (c), some solutions did not correctly show a boundary case when ( $d=1 / 2$ or $d=1$ ).


## Question $3 \quad[2+3+7+2(+1+1)=14(+1+1)]$

- Many either made an error in time complexity analysis or overcomplicated the analysis.


## Question $4 \quad[2+6+4=12$ marks $]$

- Parts (a) and (c) were well done.
- In (b), many solutions mistakenly omitted terms in the expression for number of nodes, which resulted in an easier solution.


## Question 5 [9 marks]

- Many solutions returned keys instead of values, which was not penalized.
