Question 1 [5 marks]

- This part was well done.

Question 2 [3+3+3=9 marks]

- In part (c), some solutions did not correctly show a boundary case when ($d = 1/2$ or $d = 1$).

Question 3 [2+3+7+2(+1+1)=14(+1+1)]

- Many either made an error in time complexity analysis or overcomplicated the analysis.

Question 4 [2+6+4=12 marks]

- Parts (a) and (c) were well done.
- In (b), many solutions mistakenly omitted terms in the expression for number of nodes, which resulted in an easier solution.

Question 5 [9 marks]

- Many solutions returned keys instead of values, which was not penalized.
