1 Structure and data definitions

(define-struct garb (name material size))
;; A garb is a structure (make-garb n m s), where
;; n is a string,
;; m is a symbol 'paper, 'metal, or 'plastic, and
;; s is a symbol 'small, 'medium, 'large, or 'any.

(define-struct customer (name habitat size))
;; A customer is a structure (make-customer n h s), where
;; n is a string,
;; h is a symbol 'land, 'water, or 'air,
;; s is a symbol 'small, 'medium, or 'large.
```
