

Match - A match occurs when two participants have filled out questionnaires that indicate they will be compatible.

No definition of “compatible”, no occurrence of “compat” in this context.

Triple Answer Questions - For each triple answer question, the participant selects the answer that best describes themselves. Then the participant selects the answer that best describes their ideal match. Finally, the participant rates how important it is for their match to have selected the desired answer for that question.

Balanced match --- A party matching algorithm which aims to maximize the total match compatibility for each pair of matched users

Match compatibility | The amount that the two individuals in a possible match are compatible, from 0 to 100%. Higher is better. This is determined by the two users' submitted questionnaires and preferences.

Matching works by not finding the best match for any individual user but by finding good matches for every user.
